WINTER CONCERT - December 18th

We are excited and looking forward to hosting our Winter Concert. Our students, under the guidance of our music teacher, Ms. Kreil, are working hard and they are excited and eager to perform. We will be hosting two performances at our school on the evening of December 18th. In order to accommodate as many spectators as possible, we are going to have two presentations during the evening.

Pre-K students: Both our **AM and PM** Pre-K students will come only for the <u>first</u> presentation (starts at 5:30 PM). **Mrs. Chin will communicate specific drop off and pick up times with families.

Kindergarten students: AM Kindergarten students will come only for the <u>first</u> presentation (starts at 5:30 PM). **PM** Kindergarten students will be here only for the <u>second</u> presentation (starts at 6:45 PM). **Mrs. Curran will communicate specific drop off and pick up times with families.

Grades 1-5 students will be here for <u>both</u> presentations. We ask that all grades 1 -5 students arrive at the school between 5:10-5:15. Students will meet in their classrooms with their teachers.

PRESENTATIONS:

Please understand that we can only accommodate a maximum number of spectators in the gymnasium at a time due to our seating capacity. Therefore, we are hosting two shows so that our families can come and watch.

Spectators will be determined by student last name:

- Performance 1 5:30-6:15 PreK (AM & PM), Kindergarten (AM), all grades 1-5 Parents/guardians of students with last name A-L
- Performance 2 6:45-7:30 Kindergarten (PM), all grades 1-5 Parents/guardians of students with last name M-Z

SEATING CAPACITY: To ensure we remain within our legal capacity, each student can have <u>2 people</u> come to the performance.



ATTENDANCE

Here are the Red Deer Public Schools attendane codes, which are standard for the entire district. This should provide clarity for families with students in different grades at various schools within the district.

V-I - Verified Absence Illness	Used when a guardian verifies a student's absence is due to illness.		
V-O - Verified Absence Other	Used when a guardian verifies a student's absence for a reason other than illness.		
A - Absence that has not been verified by a parent	Used when a student misses an entire class/attendance period and has not been verified by the guardian.		
L - Late	Used when a student arrives after the start of the school day.		

VERIFYING ABSENCES

When verifying your student's absence, you can do so by email or phone.

When leaving a message, please clearly state the following information:

- Your Name
- Your Student's Name
- Your Student's Teacher
- Reason for Absence (for example, if illness, please share details)
